Exclusions and Things to Note

Exclusions:

You are NOT eligible to receive this scholarship if you:

- are residing in Perth, Western Australia at time of application, admission or commencement of your studies with Murdoch University; or
- are an Australian citizen or permanent residency visa holder; or
- have or are granted a visa type that is not a Subclass 500 Student visa; or
- have received a Subclass 500 Student visa rejection as notified by the Australian Government's Department of Home Affairs; or
- are not required to pay international student tuition fees; or
- are admitted to Murdoch University in an intake that falls outside of the eligible 2021 intakes; or
- are admitted and commence enrolment in Murdoch University's Bachelor of Science / Doctor of Veterinary Medicine course or relating units;
- have received an Australian Government scholarship that covers all or part of your tuition fees; or
- are able to travel to Perth, Western Australia; or
- have an incomplete Murdoch University degree; or
- · are transferring from one of Murdoch's offshore campus locations

Note that the Scholarship:

- is for new international students who are admitted and commence their studies online whilst travel to Perth, Western Australia is not possible.
- is a 40% reduction of the eligible enrolled courses and units;
- · only applies:
 - o in respect of eligible units, forming part of eligible courses, delivered online; and
 - during such time as new international students are unable to travel to Western Australia due to government travel restrictions. Once travel is possible, the following will apply:
 - if a student has Accepted their Murdoch Letter of Offer, whilst Murdoch would expect them to make arrangements to relocate to Perth, in the event that the student is not able to arrive before classes commence, Murdoch would honour the offered Scholarship for their first teaching period enrolment but revoke the Scholarship for any future enrolled teaching periods, or
 - if a student commences their enrolment at Murdoch and it is prior to the admitted intake period census date, Murdoch would honour the offered Scholarship for the current teaching period enrolment but revoke the Scholarship for any future enrolled teaching periods, or
 - if a student commences their enrolment at Murdoch and is it after the admitted intake period census date, Murdoch would honour the offered Scholarship for the current teaching period enrolment but revoke the Scholarship for any future enrolled teaching periods, or
 - if a student has not Accepted their Murdoch Letter of Offer, the revoking of the Scholarship will be at the discretion of Murdoch and confirmed in writing to the student;
- has no financial payout and is not refundable;
- will be automatically deducted from the enrolled unit tuition fee at time of enrolment;
- will not be extended beyond its prescribed duration, except where notified by Murdoch University in writing;
- · cannot be transferred to another university;
- will not be applied to tuition fees that are incurred:
 - o for Murdoch University's units delivered through Open Universities Australia or FutureLearn;
 - o as part of cross-institutional units completed with another university;
 - o for units undertaken at, or under an enrolment at, a Murdoch University campus outside of Western Australia; or
 - o as part of a Non-for-Award enrolment at Murdoch University;
- only applies to partial tuition fees and does not apply to any other student fee of expense;
- will be revoked if the recipient defers the start of her or his studies beyond an eligible intake and;
- can be revoked in other circumstances outlined in the Terms and Conditions which will be referenced in Murdoch University's Letter of Offer.
